TO OUR CUSTOMERS:

Notice is hereby given that on November 15, 2013, New Jersey American Water ("Company") filed with the Board of Public Utilities, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:2-21 and N.J.A.C. 14:9-7.1 et seq., an application seeking to increase rates for water and sewer service through revisions to the Purchased Water and Purchased Wastewater (Sewerage) Treatment Adjustment Clauses ("PWAC" and "PSTAC", respectively). The proposed rates would increase annual revenues by \$4,483,878 or 0.69%. The proposed change in rates provides no profits to the Company. The change merely represents a pass-through of charges to the Company from purveyors who supply water to the Company and from the cost of wastewater treatment services. Those wastewater treatment services are provided by the Ocean County Utilities Authority, the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority, and Howell Township.

The existing rates for GENERAL METERED, GENERAL SALES FOR RESALE, COMMODITY-DEMAND, OFF-PEAK DEMAND, SERVICE TO OTHER SYSTEMS, PEAKING SERVICE, AND OPTIONAL INDUSTRIAL WHOLESALE WATER CUSTOMERS served throughout the State of New Jersey, are proposed to be adjusted as follows:

PURCHASED WATER ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE (PWAC)

In addition to all other charges for metered service, the following additional charges, per Rate Schedule O-1 of the Company's Tariff B.P.U. No. 8, per 100 gallons, per 1,000 gallons, per 10 cubic feet and per 100 cubic feet for all sales will be made to recover increases in purchased water costs not currently included in the consumption or any other charge:
