

Atlantic City Electric Company 2014/2015 Annual Compliance Filing for the Universal Service Fund Program Factor Within the Societal Benefits Charge Rate

Dear Secretary Izzo:

Pursuant to the Board of Public Utilities' ("Board") Order dated June 22, 2005, an annual compliance filing for prospective Universal Service Fund ("USF") rates is required to be made on or by July 1st of each year. Enclosed, therefore, for filing in connection with the above-captioned USF proceeding are an original and eleven (11) copies of Atlantic City Electric Company's ("ACE" or the "Company") 2014/2015 USF compliance filing. Kindly acknowledge receipt of this filing by date stamping the enclosed copy of this letter and returning same in the enclosed self-addressed, stamped envelope.

In order to streamline the Board's review and processing of this proceeding, the State's electric and gas utilities, consistent with past practice, have presented supporting documentation for joint recommendations within the compliance filing that is being filed by Public Service Electric and Gas Company. This filing documents ACE's support of a decrease in the current Statewide electric USF rate on and after October 1, 2014.



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Based upon (i) the results known to date for the 2013/2014 USF program year and (ii) the available estimates for the 2014/2015 USF program year, it is proposed that USF rates should be set to recover \$178.8 million on a Statewide basis. The details for the recovery of this \$178.8 million are set forth on the template appended hereto as Attachment A. Additionally, based upon the available estimates to date for the 2014/2015 Lifeline program year, it is proposed that Lifeline rates should be set to recover \$75.5 million on a Statewide basis. The details for the recovery of this amount are also set forth on the template appended hereto as Attachment A.

In accordance with the Board's July 16, 2003 Order, the Company has attached proposed tariff sheets, effective October 1, 2014 (Attachment B), proposing to decrease its electric USF program factor from .002133 cents per kWh (.002282 cents per kWh, including Sales and Use Tax ["SUT"]) to 0.001796 cents per kWh (.001922 cents per kWh, including SUT) and decrease its Lifeline charge from .000828 cents per kWh (.000886 cents per kWh, including SUT) to .000690 cents per kWh (.000738 cents per kWh, including SUT).

Since the proposed USF and Lifeline rates are decreasing for 2014/2015, we understand that public hearings will not be required and, therefore, no proposed public notice is included with this filing.

The Company respectfully requests that the Board accept this filing and issue an Order approving a decrease in the current Statewide electric USF rate as outlined herein for electric service on and after October 1, 2014.
