

## TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES:

By this Petition, South Jersey Gas Company ("South Jersey" or the "Company"), hereby requests that the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("BPU" or the "Board") pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 48:2-14 and *N.J.A.C.* 14:1-5.5 approve the municipal consent granted by the Township of Upper Pittsgrove, Salem County, New Jersey (the "Township"). In support of its Petition, South Jersey states the following:

#### BACKGROUND

- 1. South Jersey is a regulated public utility engaged in the transmission, distribution, transportation and sale of natural gas in its defined service territory within the State of New Jersey. As such, South Jersey is subject to the jurisdiction of the Board. Within its service territory, the Company services approximately 360,000 customers.
- 2. South Jersey currently provides natural gas service within the Township and serves approximately 235 residential and 18 commercial customers. South Jersey anticipates customer growth within its defined service territory to be approximately 1% annually and for the next 3-5 years.
- South Jersey has the capacity necessary to ensure a continuation of its natural gas service and does not foresee any concerns regarding its ability to meet the existing and future demands of the Township.

4. Moreover, the Township is serviced by South Jersey's Glassboro Division customer service center located at 142 South Main Street, Glassboro, New Jersey 08028. The Glassboro Division will continue to serve South Jersey's customers within the Township for the foreseeable future. No modifications to the location or hours of operation of the center are proposed by virtue of this Petition.

#### MUNICIPAL CONSENT

- 5. On or about October 7, 1947, pursuant to ordinance, the Township consented to:
  (1) the Company furnishing natural gas service in the Township; and (2) the Company's use of the streets (the "Original Consent"). See October 7, 1947 Ordinance attached hereto as Exhibit "A".
- 6. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:3-15, the portion of the Original Consent applicable to the Company's use of the streets expired on October 7, 1997. Specifically, N.J.S.A. 48:3-15 provides, in relevant part, that "the board or body of such municipality authorized to grant consent may, by ordinance and not otherwise, grant for a period not exceeding fifty years, the right to use the streets petitioned for."
- 7. By virtue of this fifty (50) year statutory limitation, South Jersey obtained the renewed consent of the Township applicable to its use of the streets. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 2015-6, the Township acknowledged the Original Consent and granted exclusive consent and permission to South Jersey to lay and construct its pipes and mains and related appurtenances and facilities within the streets, alleys, squares and public places within the Township for a period of Fifty (50) years. *See* Ordinance No. 2015-6 attached hereto as Exhibit "B".
- By letter to the Township dated October 19, 2015, South Jersey accepted and agreed to the terms and conditions of such municipal consent pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:3-16. A

true and correct copy of the Company's October 19, 2015 correspondence is attached hereto as

Exhibit "C".

MISCELLANEOUS

9. A proposed public notice is attached to this Petition as Exhibit "D". A copy of

this Petition will be served on the Clerk of the Township and the Clerk of the Board of Chosen

Freeholders.

10. N.J.S.A. 48:2-14 requires Board approval of a municipal consent granted by a

municipality to a public utility subject to the Board's jurisdiction. The consent, which is the

subject matter of this Petition, complies with all statutory and administrative requirements

necessary for its approval. The Board's approval of the consent is necessary and proper for the

public convenience and properly conserves the public interests.

WHEREFORE, South Jersey Gas respectfully requests that the Board grant the

following:

1. Approve the municipal consent granted to South Jersey by the Township; and

2. Provide any and other further relief deemed just and equitable.

AN ORDINANCE GIVING AND GRANTING CONSENT AND PER-MISSION TO SOUTH JERSEY GAS COMPANY TO FURNISH GAS FOR LIGHT, HEAT AND POWER IN THE TOWNSHIP OF TEPPER PITTEGROUS, IN THE COUNTY OF SALEN

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Typer Pittagreve in the County of Salem:

- 1. That consent and permission to furnish gas for light, heat and power in the Township of **Upper Planage of Planage** in the County of sales is hereby given and granted to South Jersey Gas Company, subject to approval of such consent and permission by the Board of Public Utility Commissioners of the State of New Jersey.
