IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF MOUNT OLIVE VILLAGES WATER COMPANY, INC. APPROVAL OF AN INCREASE IN RATE FOR SERVICE DOCKET NO. WR16050390

Notice is hereby given that on May 16, 2016, Mount Olive Villages Water Company (Company) filled a Petition with the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (Board) in Docket No. WR16050390, together with revised tariff sheets containing increased rates for water service rendered on and after thirty (20) days from the filling date of the Company's Petition, or at such later date as the Board may determine. The proposed new rates would yield additional approximately \$158,650.00 or 112.3% over current base rates and are required so that Company may make necessary capital improvements and repairs to its water system and as further described in the Petition.

The percentage increase is proposed to be allocated as follows:

a) Public Fire Protection Service: 222% increase 5 General Metered Service: 222% increase c) Consumption Charges 304% increase d) Private Fire Protection Service 222% increase

The following comparison of present and proposed rates will permit customers to determine the effect upon them of the proposed increased rates. Any assistance required by customers in this regard will be furnished by the Company upon request. The present and proposed rate schedules are as follows:
