This law firm represents the New Jersey Large Energy Users Coalition ("NJLEUC"). This letter is written in response to the March 14, 2018 letter of Gregory Eisenstark, counsel to Jersey Central Power & Light Company ("JCP&L"), regarding NJLEUC's pending motion to intervene in this proceeding.

In the letter, JCP&L states that it would not oppose NJLEUC's motion if NJLEUC files a list of members that are currently JCP&L customers. In response, and in accordance with the Board's ruling in I/M/O the Petition of Public Service Electric and Gas Company for Approval of the Energy Strong Program, Docket Nos. EO13020155 and GO13020156, Order dated October 30, 2013, and without waiving its right to object to the identification of some or all of its members in future proceedings, NJLEUC states that NJLEUC members that currently take electric distribution service from JCP&L include: Merck, Gerdau and DSM Nutritional Products.
