MOTION TO INTERVENE OF GOOGLE, LLC

Google, LLC ("Google") hereby moves before the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("Board"), pursuant to N.J.A.C. 1:1-16.1 *et seq.*, to permit Google to intervene as a participant in the above-captioned proceeding with all of those rights and obligations typically afforded to a participant in such proceedings. In support of its motion, Google states as follows:

- 1. On October 11, 2018, Public Service Electric and Gas Company ("PSE&G") initiated the above-captioned proceeding by filing a Petition requesting Approval of its Clean Energy Future Energy Efficiency (the "CEF-EE Petition"). The CEF-EE Petition requests approval of a six-year, \$2.5 billion investment into 22 distinct subprograms spanning residential and commercial customers in New Jersey, designed to achieve New Jersey's ambitious energy efficiency goals.
- 2. Google is a multinational technology company and developer of the Nest Learning Thermostat and the Nest Thermostat E, two of the leading smart home thermostats available in the

United States. Nest thermostats incorporate numerous features which help consumers reduce their energy consumption for heating and cooling and the Nest Learning Thermostat was the very first thermostat to be certified by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") under its Energy Star Smart Thermostat designation.¹

- 3. In addition to being able to save consumers on their heating and cooling consumption, Nest thermostats are also used by utilities across the country for demand response on hot summer afternoons through the Nest Rush Hour Rewards program. Customers participating in Rush Hour Rewards agree to let their household temperature rise a few degrees on selected days when the utility is concerned about system reliability in return for a payment or bill credit to the customer. Overall, dozens of gas and electric utilities across North America provide financial incentives to their customers for smart thermostats in order to meet their energy efficiency and demand response goals.
- 4. PSE&G currently offers a rebate to its residential gas and electric customers who purchase smart thermostats as part of their Smart Thermostat Subprogram as part of their EE 17 Program that was approved by the BPU last year. That Subprogram also included a low-income pilot program to install smart thermostats in low-income multi-family buildings.²

- 5. The CEF-EE Petition proposes, in part, to continue to provide rebates to residential customers for smart thermostats in the Residential Efficient Products Subprogram thereby furthering the state's goal of reducing energy costs for its citizens.
- 6. PSE&G also proposes to enlarge its Income Eligible program to help lower income customers save on their gas and electric bills and that program will also include the direct installation of smart thermostats.
- 7. In addition, PSE&G proposes other subprograms, such as the Smart Home Pilot Subprogram, to "test new and innovative smart home concepts," ultimately furthering the State's energy efficiency goals by involving homeowners on an individual and customized basis. Google is one of the industry leaders is smart home technology.
- 8. N.J.A.C. 1:1-16.6(a) provides the standard for participation in a proceeding before this Board. The party seeking to participate must show that it has a significant interest in the outcome of the case. In granting a motion to intervene, the Board must consider whether the participant's interest is likely to add constructively to the case without causing undue delay or confusion. See N.J.A.C. 1:1-16.6(b).
- 9. Google has a significant interest in the outcome of this proceeding. As a leading developer of smart technology, including Nest smart thermostats, the programs proposed by PSE&G will likely involve deployment of Google products and services. Google already participates in energy efficiency programs with PSE&G and believes that the subprograms proposed by PSE&G in the CEF-EE Petition will enlarge this opportunity and bring further benefits to customers in New Jersey.

10. Second, Google's participation will add constructively to this case. Google will

participate in discussions with the parties in this matter to explain how its technology can assist

PSE&G and the state in reaching its energy efficiency goals.

11. Finally, intervention by Google will not cause confusion or delay the conclusion of

this proceeding. Google is filing for intervention pursuant to the terms of the Board's Order.

Google's intervention will clarify certain issues and contribute to the development of a complete

record based on its unique, significant interests. Moreover, Google will not seek to delay the

proceeding in any manner.
