Network Billing Systems, LLC Status Update to BCN Telecom, Inc. Notice of Service Termination

Dear Ms. Camacho.

On or about April 8, 2019, BCN Telecom, Inc. ("BCN") served Network Billing Systems LLC ("NBS") with formal notice of service termination in connection with a wholesale agreement between the companies. NBS currently serves certain of its customers using services provided through the agreement with BCN. NBS submits this letter to apprise the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("Board") regarding the status of the dispute.

Following initial notice of the proposed service termination, NBS reached out to BCN and entered into discussions aimed at resolving the situation in a manner that would avert any impact upon NBS customers. Based upon those discussions, NBS and BCN have reached agreement to adopt a "standstill period," delaying the proposed termination for a period of time in order to provide NBS with sufficient time to migrate its customers away from the BCN network. Consequently, the termination of services that BCN proposed to conduct in New Jersey will not occur. Instead NBS will migrate any of its customers currently supported through the underlying BCN services to another underlying carrier. This process is expected to be seamless and should have no impact upon NBS's end-user customers.

NBS will notify the Board when the migration of its New Jersey customers away from the BCN network is completed. Should there be a change in the companies' arrangements such that an interruption or discontinuance of service could occur, NBS will notify the Board and comply fully with any applicable Board requirements.
