### Background

On February 21, 2018, Public Service Electric and Gas Company's ("PSE&G" or "the Company") filed a letter petition ("CSG Petition") with the Board of Public Utilities ("Board", "BPU") for approval of its proposed Service Agreement with UMM Energy Partners, LLC ("UMM") pursuant to PSE&G's Rate Schedule CSG-Contract Gas Service.

UMM operates an electric cogeneration facility in Montclair, New Jersey which provides service under contract to Montclair State University. PSE&G presently provides firm gas transportation service to UMM under its TSG-NF tariff.

PSE&G's CSG tariff was established pursuant to the standards set by the Board in a generic proceeding which examined the standards applicable to gas distribution discounts and associated terms and conditions.<sup>1</sup> The CSG tariff enables PSE&G to offer discount rates where the customer presents an "Economically Viable Bypass" or "Other Considerations." Furthermore, the CSG tariff provides that any such offers require approval by the Board..<sup>3</sup>

UMM initially submitted an application to PSE&G seeking the proposed rates for service under the "Economically Viable Bypass" provision of Rate Schedule CSG. Petition, p. 3. Transcontinental Gas Pipeline Corporation ("Transco") owns and operates an interstate natural gas pipeline near the UMM facility which, if interconnected with UMM, could provide gas delivery service directly to UMM and bypass PSE&G's natural gas distribution system. *Id*, at p. 3.

On April 11, 2018, UMM filed a petition ("SBC Petition") with the Board for approval of a reduction in the Societal Benefits Charge ("SBC") applicable to its gas service under PSE&G's CSG tariff.

On April 10, 2019, PSE&G filed an amended letter petition ("Amended CSG Petition") which sought approval of an amended Service Agreement ("Amended Service Agreement").

The Amended CSG Petition was filed in response to a revised CSG application submitted to PSE&G by UMM under the "Other Considerations" provision of the CSG tariff. Amended CSG Petition, p. 3. The Amended Service Agreement further provides *inter alia* that UMM will withdraw its request for a SBC discount and will not, during the term of the Amended Service Agreement, seek a reduction in the SBC. Amended Service Agreement, paragraph 3.2. By letter dated April 16, 2019, counsel for UMM stated that UMM "wholly supports" the Amended CSG Petition.

#### Recommendation

Based on the review of documents and information provided by PSE&G and UMM, Rate Counsel does not object to the terms of service set forth in the proposed Amended Service Agreement.

UMM's amended CSG application was submitted to PSE&G under the "Other Considerations" provision of the CSG tariff. Amended CSG Petition, p. 3. The "Other Considerations" provision of the CSG tariff provides for negotiated CSG rates where such rates "are necessary to prevent "economic bypass of the Company's [PSE&G] distribution system." PSE&G CSG tariff, Sheet 112. Here, UMM has a credible bypass alternative with the nearby Transco pipeline. The proposed Amended Service Agreement provides assurance of system revenue going forward which would not exist absent the proposed agreement, given the

possibility of a system bypass with the nearby Transco pipeline. Otherwise, this revenue would

need to be recovered at some point from other ratepayers, all else equal. Furthermore, the

Amended Service Agreement binds UMM to take distribution service from PSE&G for the 20-

year term of agreement, thereby precluding the possibility of bypass during the term of the

Amended Service Agreement.

In addition, with sufficient distribution facilities in place to serve UMM, the marginal

cost to provide distribution service to UMM is de minimus and the proposed delivery charges

exceed the marginal cost to serve UMM. Finally, the Amended Service Agreement provides that

UMM will withdraw its pending SBC reduction petition and will not seek a discount in the SBC

during the term of the agreement.
