Direct Gas Purchases

During November 2020, the Company purchased 4,639,864 dts of gas from producer-suppliers and gas marketers to meet total sendout and storage service requirements. Of this amount 1,977,408 dts were delivered to city gate stations by Transcontinental Gas Pipeline, LLC ("Transco"), 0 dts were purchased and delivered into storage by Dominion Energy Transmission Inc. (DET), while the remaining 1,507,544 dts were delivered by Columbia Gas Transmission, LLC ("Columbia"). This gas was purchased at delivered prices ranging from \$0.2461 to \$3.0132 per dt with a weighted average price of \$2.074 per dts.

3. <u>Pipeline Transportation Service</u>

During November 2020, the Company received at its interstate pipeline city gate stations 2,214,872 Dts of gas that was owned by certain of its residential, commercial, and industrial customers. The Company retained 1.43 percent of said gas as line loss.

4. <u>Capacity Assignment</u>

In November 2020, there were no assignments of the Company's firm interstate pipeline capacity to end-use customers within its service territory. The Company did assign 5,651,692 Dts of its long-haul transportation services (in both the production and market areas) to third parties along with 2,447,000 Dts of its market area pipeline capacity. The Company also assigned 240,000 Dts of its firm transportation on the TGP pipeline system.

5. Gas Sales in Interstate Markets

During November 2020, the Company made gas sales in the interstate market of 2,454,309 Dts.

6. <u>LNG</u>

As of November 3, 2020, there was 395,760 Mcf of LNG in storage in the Company's McKee City LNG storage tank. During the month of November 2020, the company, injected 0 into its tank. There was 7,406 Mcf of LNG used at McKee City as boil-off and/or vaporized.
