Dear Secretary Camacho-Welch:

The undersigned is Assistant General Counsel to Atlantic City Electric Company (“ACE” or the “Company”). By way of follow up to the Order of Approval issued by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (the “Board” or “BPU”) on January 27, 2021 (the “Order”), ACE is providing an update on the status of the above referenced office relocation.

As stated in the Petition and as referenced in the Order, the Company anticipated that the Ventnor City office (the “New Office”) would be renovated and open for business by August 1, 2021. Order at page 1. Unfortunately, due to ongoing complications attributable to the Pandemic and a shortage of construction-related supplies and workers, the relocation to the New Office must be delayed.¹ ACE now anticipates that the renovation will be completed by October 15, 2021.

Rest assured that, in the interim, *the Atlantic City office will continue to be available to ACE customers for drop off payments.* The Company also affirms all of the obligations, terms, and conditions embodied in the Order.² No modification of the Order is being requested.

¹ Numerous construction-related supplies essential to the retrofitting of the New Office (i.e., lumber) are on backorder.

² Inasmuch as the current office in Atlantic City is *not* “unavailable before completion of the equipping and relocation process” of the New Office, there is no need to develop a contingency plan. Order at 4.


