CERTIFICATION IN SUPPORT OF MOTION TO INTERVENE

#### I, MICHELE L. TILLEY, do hereby certify as follows:

- 1. I am Director of Budgets and Rates for Intervenor, Middlesex Water Company ("Middlesex"), in this matter. I am familiar with the facts and circumstances concerning the matter.
  - 2. I make this Certification in support of Intervenor's Notice of Motion to Intervene.
- 3. Middlesex is a duly authorized public utility corporation of the State of New Jersey having its principal place of business at 485C Route One South, Suite 400, Iselin, New Jersey 08830.
- 4. Middlesex will be substantially, specifically, and directly affected by the outcome of this proceeding.
- 5. Middlesex procures water under contract with the New Jersey American Water Company, Inc. ("NJAWC") through the Elizabethtown System of NJAWC. Middlesex is charged for purchased water under NJAWC Rate Schedule G entitled "Sales for Resale Service to Other Systems" and Rate Schedule O-1 entitled "Purchased Water Adjustment Clause (PWAC)". Under the contract currently in effect, Middlesex is required to purchase a minimum of three (3) million gallons of water per day from NJAWC. Using the Rate Schedules G and O-1 currently in effect results in a minimum annual cost of approximately \$3.2 million dollars. NJAWC is proposing to increase the rates charged to

Middlesex under Rate Schedule G by 11.7%, which will increase the minimum annual cost for water service by approximately \$326,700.

6. As a contract customer affected by this request of NJAWC for a change in rates for water service, Middlesex is entitled to intervene in this proceeding. Accordingly, Middlesex hereby formally seeks leave to intervene in this matter, with full rights and obligations as a party to participate in pre-

hearing conferences, present and cross-examine witnesses at hearing, and file briefs.

- 7. Middlesex's interest in this proceeding will not be adequately protected by any of the other parties. As a large use contract customer, it is significantly different from the majority of other customers of NJAWC. Therefore, it is critical that Middlesex be permitted to intervene for the purpose of representing its own interests.
- 8. Middlesex has historically been granted leave to intervene in NJAWC's rate case proceedings, including but not limited to NJAWC's last concluded rate proceedings under OAL Docket No. PUC-17894-2019S and BPU Docket No. WR19121516. Middlesex has also historically been granted leave to intervene in NJAWC's PWAC proceedings including NJAWC's recently filed PWAC proceeding under BPU Docket No. WR21111220 and last concluded PWAC proceeding under OAL Docket No. PUC 01163-2021S and BPU Docket No. WR20110719.
